- Ensure young people leaving care have easy access to a range of accommodation that meets their needs
- Ensure that young people know their rights and understand their tenancy agreement
- Tailor our tenancy sign-up procedures to support young people to understand them fully
- Prevent homelessness we will support young people leaving care to sustain their tenancy, to learn the necessary skills to maintain a home
- Work with our suppliers to provide furniture packages to young people with reduced income

**Life skills and mentoring**We will / we aim to:



- Support young people to connect with others who have lived experience, to encourage and promote their wellbeing
- Support young people to connect with their community and to utilise local assets
- Signpost young people to partners that offer a range of activities / events
- We support young people to learn how to manage their finances and increase their income

- Offer work skills training, support into employment and apprenticeships to all our young people
- We will offer an enhanced support package when a care leaver commences employment with us, such as a peer mentor
